And for Supply and Delivery of Drugs & Medicines (Charity — Additional 2 CY 2018), Drugs & Medicines (For Dialysis CY 2018), Drugs & Medicines (Charity CY 2019), Medical Supplies, Radiology Supplies, Laboratory Supplies (Anatomical) and Dialysis Supplies should have experience in undertaking similar projects within the last two (2) years with an amount of at least 25% of the proposed project for bidding. The Eligibility Check/Screening as well as the Preliminary Examination of Bids shall use non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria. Detailed Bid-Evaluation & Post-Qualification of the lowest-calculated bid shall be conducted, and;

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.
