The one-month cycle menu would be provided to the winning bidder thirty days in advance before the actual implementation commence. Raw materials / ingredients to be used in the menu are affordable, accessible and available year-round, to ensure that the winning provider would be free from any problems that may encounter from unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances.

2. Meal Schedule and Distribution

c. Winning bidder shall ensure that damages / spoilage of prepared supplementary food are prevented during transit to all pantries. Sufficient and sanitary transporting equipment such as suitable delivery food service crates shall be provided by the winning bidder.

To ensure the foods served are clean, safe and according to standard nutritional requirement, NCMH Nut-Dietitians are always ready and available in all the pavilions that will be catered for supplementary food. Tasting and checking of the quality of snacks to be served would be an utmost priority for every ND on duty. Food Evaluation Form would be accomplished daily and it would be the basis for any sanction / penalty.

Under Item B. Technical Logistics and Organizational Competence

1. Cooks and Food Service Handlers

- a. The winning bidder cooks and food service handler must comply with the city health office requirement of securing health certificate. Checking of health certificate will be done randomly to ensure that it matches with the list of currently employed food handlers.
- b. The winning bidder cooks and food service handlers must wear personal protective equipment such as gloves, white caps, apron, appropriate working shoes and face mask during preparation until the delivery of the supplementary into NCMH different parties including Camarin Extension.

Other Issues:

1. Failure to Deliver on Time

As indicated in our Terms of Reference, the delivery time of the Supplementary should be from 1:30pm to 2:00pm. Failure to abide so will lead to different level of sanctions as indicated below:

- **1.1.** Delivery between 2:01pm to 2:30pm will be charge of 1% of the total on the day contract price.
- **1.2.** Delivery between 2:31pm to 3:30pm will be charge of 2% of the total on the day contract price.
- **1.3.** Delivery between 3:31 to 4:00pm will be charge of 5% the total on the day contract price.
- **1.4.** Delivery beyond 4:01pm will be charge to rejection of delivery.

2. Report of Food Spoilage

As written in our Terms of Reference, the winning bidder shall seek daily approval and taste test to the NCMH Nutrition and Dietetics Service prior to the distribution of the supplementary to different NCMH Pavilion pantries. Incident of spoilage will lead to the following sanctions:

- **2.1. First Offense-** written warning and rejection of the food prepared.
- **2.2. Second Offense-** winning bidder will be charged 10% of the total on the day contract price accompanied by rejection of the food prepared.
- **2.3. Third Offense-** Termination and rejection of the food prepared.

3. Below Specification

It will be strictly monitored that the winning bidders should prepare afternoon snacks with 500kcal. Failure to do so will compromise the needs of the patients and its objective to provide weight gain for the patients who are nutritionally ill. Because of the that, strictly 500kcal will be imposed. Failure to do so will lead to following sanctions:

- **3.1. First Offense-** when the winning bidder failed to provide below 500kal three (3) times within 83 days, will charged with 2% of the total on the day contract price.
- **3.2. Second Offense-** when the winning bidder failed to provide below 500kcal for the fourth (4th) time within 83 days, will charged with 5% of the total on the day contract price.

3.3. Third Offense- when the winning bidder failed to provide below 500kcal for the fifth (5th) time within 83 days, it will be charged with termination of contract.

Other Matters:

- A. Eligibility requirements and technical proposal should be in one folder and financial proposal in a separate folder, with shoelace on top or ring binded instead of fastener, table of contents and index tabs in words, not numbers.
- B. Folder of Eligibility requirements and technical proposal should be placed in one envelope. And folder of Financial proposal should be in another envelope. Both envelopes shall then be placed in one mother envelope marked as "Original Bid"
- C. Documents should be arranged chronologically according to the checklist issued.
- D. Color code for folders and envelope: WHITE
- E. All other provisions on the bidding documents which are not affected shall remain in effect.
- F. The deadline for Submission and Opening of Bids is scheduled on June 28, 2021, 9:00 AM, Monday at the BAC Conference Room, National Center for Mental Health Compound. Mandaluyong City.
- G. Any bid submitted after the deadline for submission shall be declared "LATE" and shall NOT be accepted.
- H. The BAC shall open the bids immediately after the deadline for submission and receipt of bids.
